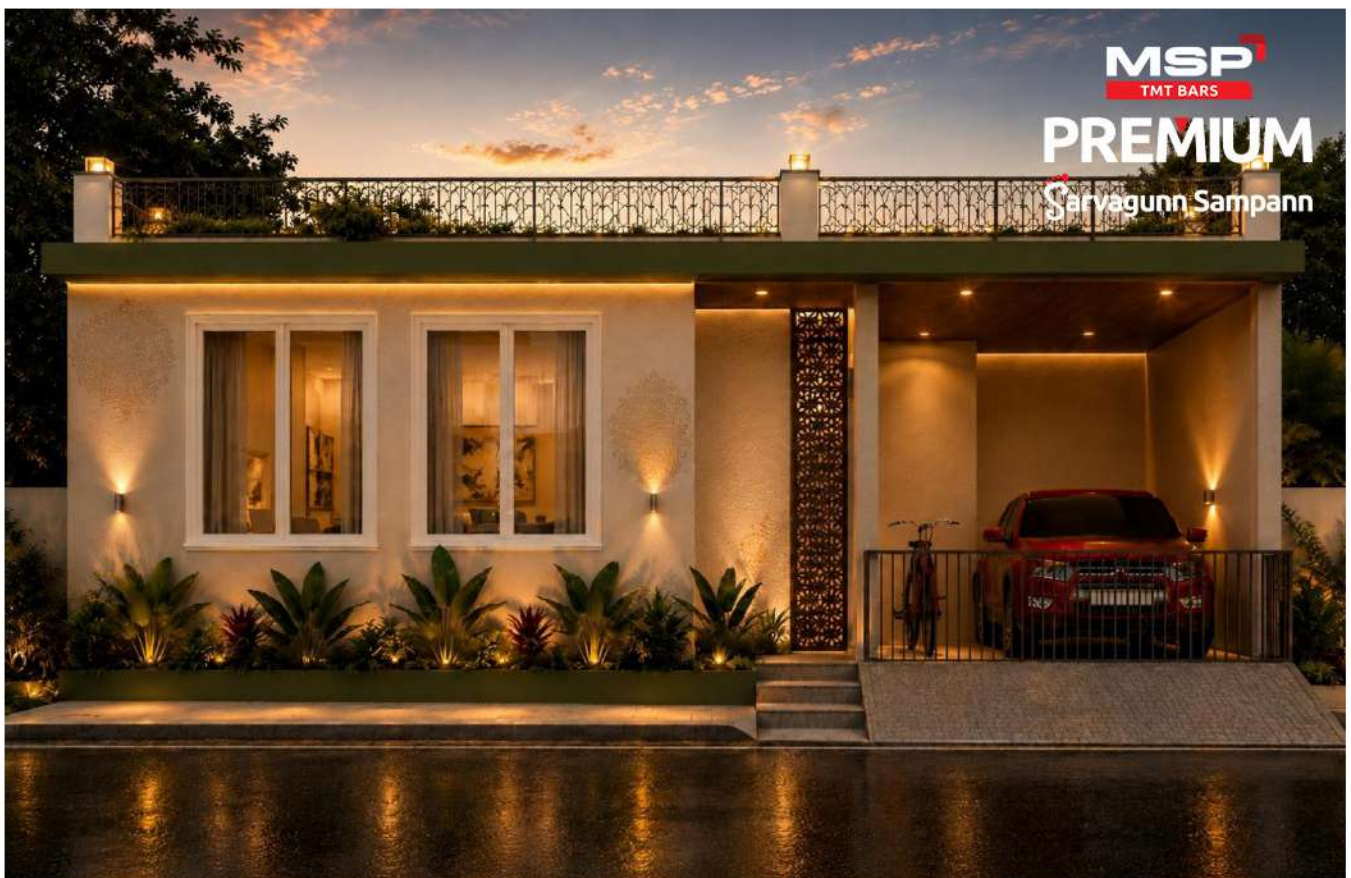


Ground Floor - 3 BHK Generous House Plan - 1350 Sq. Ft.

This premium 3 BHK ground floor house plan is designed for a **32 ft × 42 ft plot**, delivering **1,350 sq ft** of thoughtfully planned living space. The layout features a master bedroom, guest bedroom, child bedroom, study room, two toilets, a grand living room, separate dining area, kitchen, puja room, dedicated entrance lobby, and covered car parking — a thoroughly complete home for larger families. Room proportions are **generous** across the board, with an especially expansive living room and well-sized bedrooms. The study room adjacent to the master bedroom, child bedroom with shelf storage, and wardrobe in the guest bedroom reflect careful attention to everyday needs. Internal circulation flows naturally from the entrance through the common areas to the private zones.

On Vastu, the kitchen placement in the **East-Southeast** is well-aligned with guidelines, and Toilet in the Northwest is correctly positioned. The puja room in the South-Centre is functional too.

Suitable for large and multi-generational families, this plan is an excellent choice for premium plotted developments and independent residential projects.
